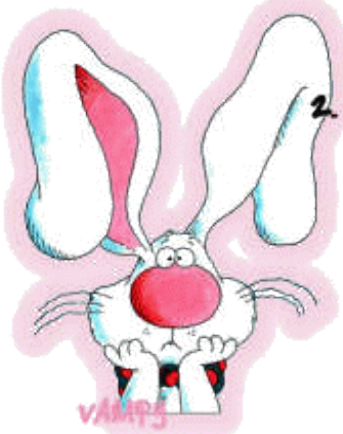

TIPS from the Easter Bunny

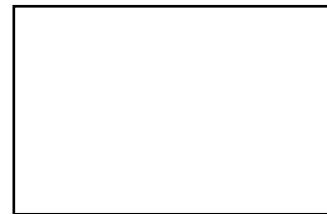
1. Don't put all your eggs in one basket
