Missing Husker Football? Here's some Fun Facts



Nebraska has had three(3) Heisman Trophy winners in their history- Johnny Rogers(1972), Mike Rosier(1983) and Eric Couch (2001).

Tommy Fraizer scored more touch downs in the air than on the ground? 43 thrown vs 36 ran.

Nebraska has claimed Five(5) National Championships- 1970,1971,1994,1995 and 1997.

The Cornhuskers have played in 53 bowl games in their long history. They hold a negative 26-27 post season record in those games.

Nebraska football came to prominence with the hiring of Tom Osborne in 1973. While here Osborne accumulated a 255-49-3 record. He was Nebraska's longest tenured coach. Osborne Teams won the National Championships in 1994 and 1995, going undefeated 25-0 during that period, being unbeaten and untied.

Nebraska posted a 60-3-0 record between 1993-97 to end Osborne's tenure at Nebraska. That is why he is remembered so well by their fans and alumni!

As of 9-23-2017, Memorial stadium home of Nebraska, has had a record of 357 consecutive sell-outs. The stadium is referred to by their fans as "The Sea of Red", their colors being crimson and cream.


















