We will start raffling the baskets at 6:30 pm

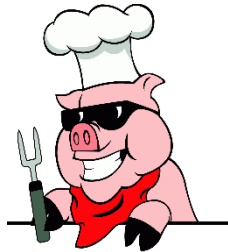

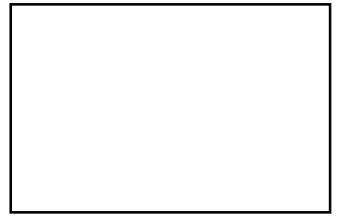
